

National Council for Agriculture Education Adult Position

The adult position on the National Council is an appointment from the NFRBMEA Board of Directors. Rich Baumann, FBM Instructor at South Central College in Minnesota is currently serving this position on the council. Rich's 3-year term will be completed at the end of 2007.

National Council Adult Position Responsibilities: The individual in this position is the spokesperson for adult education in agriculture. The National Council meets face-to-face in March and October in Washington D.C. and other locations. These meetings occupy from three to five days. In addition, conference calls for the National Council are scheduled monthly. Participation in other agricultural educational meetings and conferences is also required. The new Council member's term begins January 1, 2008.

This is the second time that NFRBMEA has had the opportunity to make this position selection. The NFRBMEA Board adopted the following criteria and process for selection of our sponsored Council member.

The person selected for the adult position to the National Council must be an Active member of NFRBMEA and NAAE. Those interested in this position should submit a letter of application explaining:

- *Why you are applying for the adult position on the council*
- *Why you feel that you would be a good selection for the position*
- *Your major concerns in regard to agricultural education and adult education in particular*
- *How your philosophy in adult education is reflected in your adult education program*
- *Your administration's level of support that allows you to serve effectively in this position*

Applicants should submit a resume that includes:

- *Information regarding your educational background and educational accomplishments*
- *Details regarding your involvement in educational organizations and other organizations on the local, regional, state, and national level*

All applicants should also provide 3 letters of recommendation.
