Position Purpose: Farm Business Management Instructors are responsible for providing instruction in record-keeping, farm business analysis interpretation, tax management, farm finance, decision making, commodity marketing, and general farm management. Instruction is delivered during individual instructional sessions at the farm business, in the instructor's office, classroom settings and seminars, and by the use of technology to facilitate distance learning.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in agriculture, agriculture education, business, finance, economics or accounting.
- Four full-time (or equivalent) years of verified related paid work experience in agricultural operations, agricultural finance, or agribusiness.
- One year of this work experience shall be within the five years immediately preceding the date of application for the credential field. The recency requirement shall be waived if the individual has two years of successful full-time (or equivalent) postsecondary teaching experience in the credential field within the last five years.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience in crop and livestock farm management.
- Background in farm business management or a related business providing client financial consultation.
- Background or experience working with diverse populations.
- Experience in developing and delivering educational programs on-line and in-person.
- Familiarity with personal computer software usage in a farm business setting.
- Demonstrated time management skills.
